All you have to do is use the retailer links provided on the easyfundraising website when ever you shop online. Select Clayton C of E Primary School P.T.F.A. as your cause when you register and each time you make a purchase online, a donation is made to us. They will send a cheque every three months to P.T.F.A.
